

Protection:

We recommend the use of door matting in all entrance areas in order to minimise the drag through of dirt from the outside. The larger the area of matting used, the less soiling of the tiles will occur.

Regular maintenance:

The maintenance will depend on the amount of use the tiles will get. We recommend the use of a mini 1000W power and 170mm water column suction vacuum cleaner. Cleaning of the tiles prior to them being put back into storage is essential as they can then be ready for use the next time they are installed.

Periodic maintenance:

After an extended period of time (depending on the type of use), you may have to carry out a more rigorous clean to refresh the tile by using an injection/extraction system (e.g. Kärcher, Taski, Advance...be careful to follow the manufacturers instructions). Also, if the tiles are installed over an extended period, the backing of the tile will have to be cleaned/wiped in order to remove any dirt/grit that may have got underneath the tiles during use as over a period of time this can damage the backing.

Stain Cleaning:

Any liquids spilt on the tiles must be quickly removed to minimise any absorption into surface.

Chewing gums can be removed by using a freezing spray.

Any residual staining can then be removed during the injection/extraction cleaning process.
